Friday said that "while the Government facilities are treating the patients for free, the private hospitals will not be allowed to charge ₹4,000 for testing the patients. ## Minor boy, CRPF cop killed in terror attack in Anantnag

A minor boy was killed along with a CRPF constable in a terrorist attack in Bijbehara area of Anantnag while the joint teams of security forces gunned down three more terrorists during an ongoing operation in Chewa Ullar area of Awantipora on Friday.

Killing of a minor boy at the hands of terrorists was widely condemned by the leaders of mainstream political parties and others.

Brigadier Vijay Mahadevan, Commander 1 sector RR, during a media briefing told reporters, "due to successful operations in the South Kashmir districts, the terrorists are frustrated and resorting to targeting unarmed civilians and security forces standing guard."

## 3 terrorists gunned down in Awantipora

According to police, "Both the injured were shifted to nearby hospital for treatment where they succumbed to their injuries". The killed boy has been identified as Nehan Yawar son of Mohd Yaseen Bhat resident of Machwa Yaripora, Kulgam while the CRPF trooper was identified as Shyamal Kumar.

Meanwhile, during an ongoing operation in Chewa Ullar area of Awantipora, the joint teams of Police, 42RR and 180Bn CRPF maintained a tight vigil during the night to prevent terrorists from escaping.

## Mamata writes to Modi against 100% FDI in coal
